We have new pupils starting with us all the time and would like to welcome them to our school. The pupils have been fantastic.

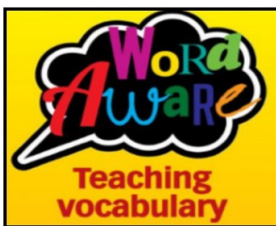
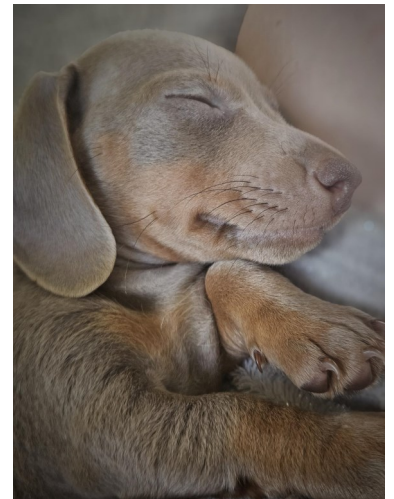
